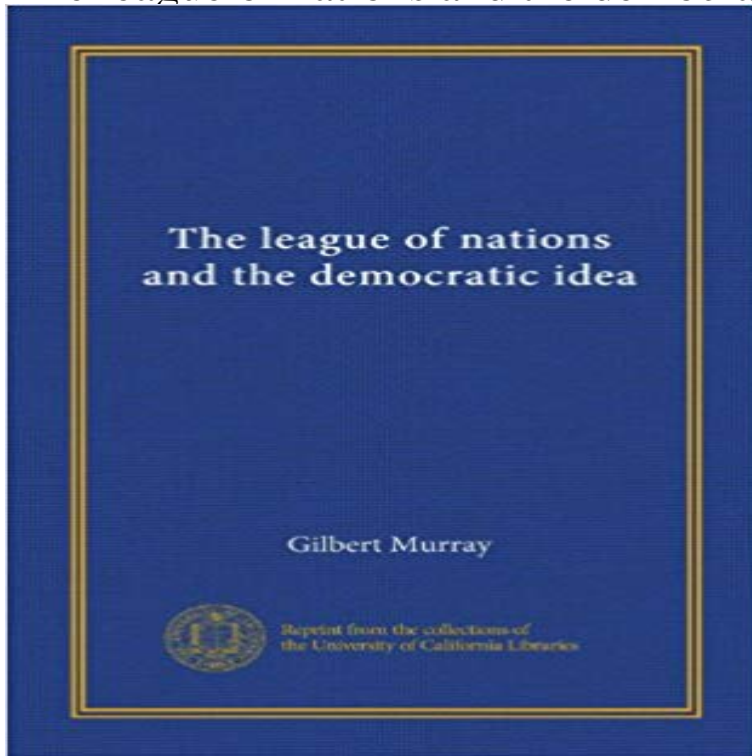


The league of nations and the democratic idea
