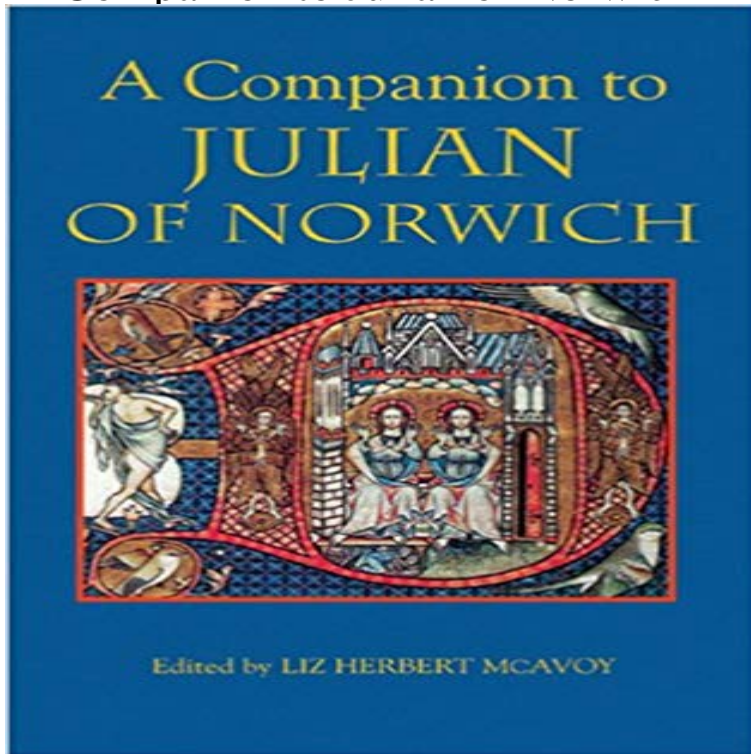


## A Companion to Julian of Norwich
