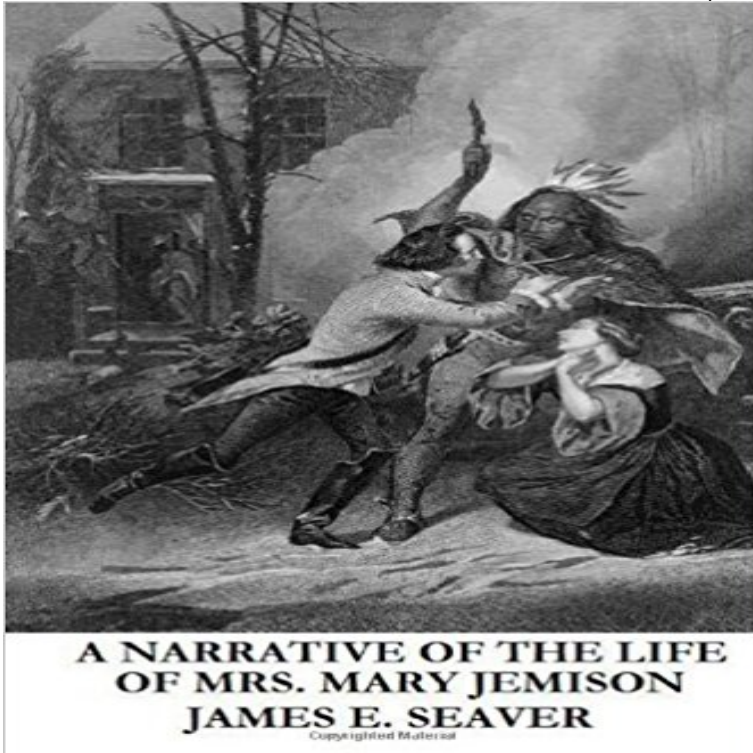


A Narrative of the Life of Mrs. Mary Jemison
