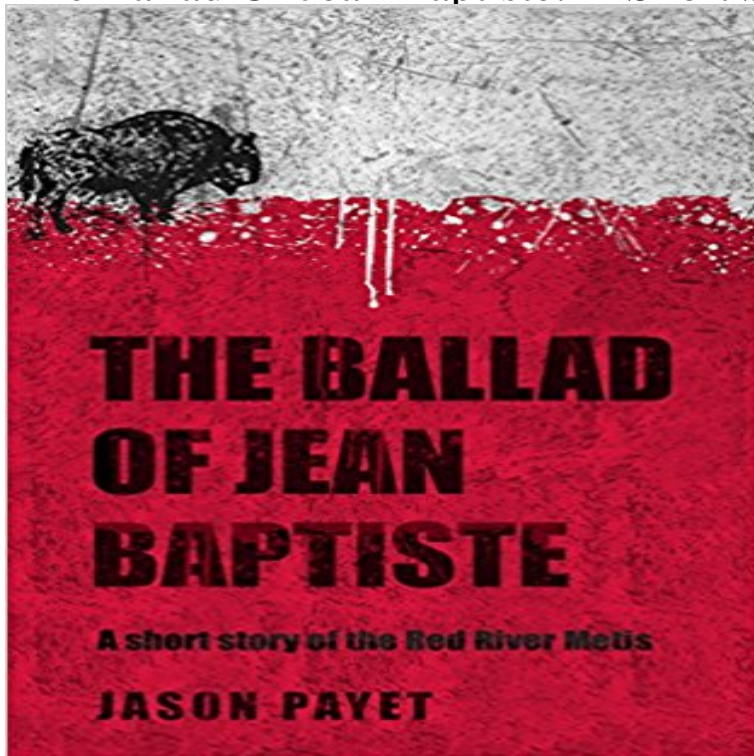


The Ballad Of Jean Baptiste: A Short Story Of The Red River Metis
