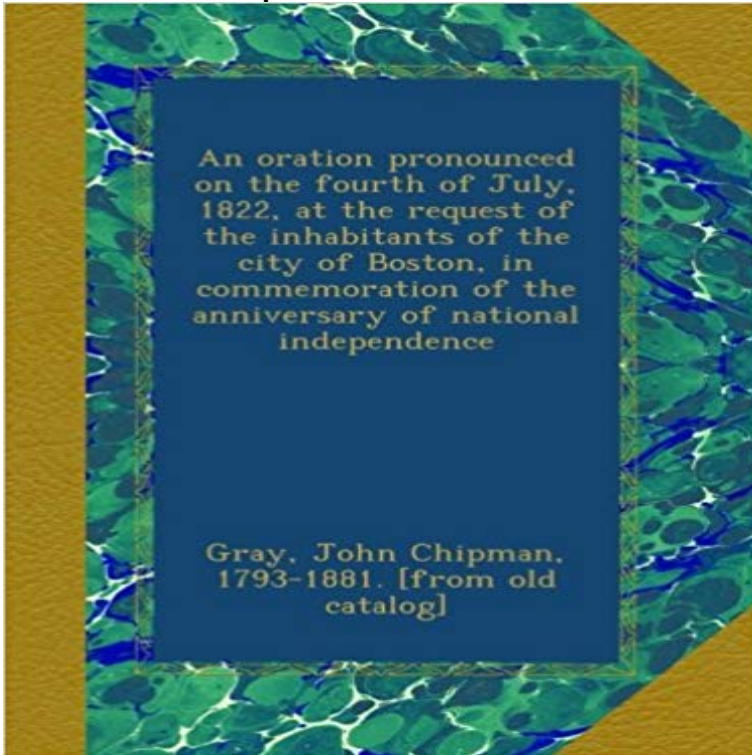


An oration pronounced on the fourth of July, 1822, at the request of the inhabitants of the city of Boston, in commemoration of the anniversary of national independence
