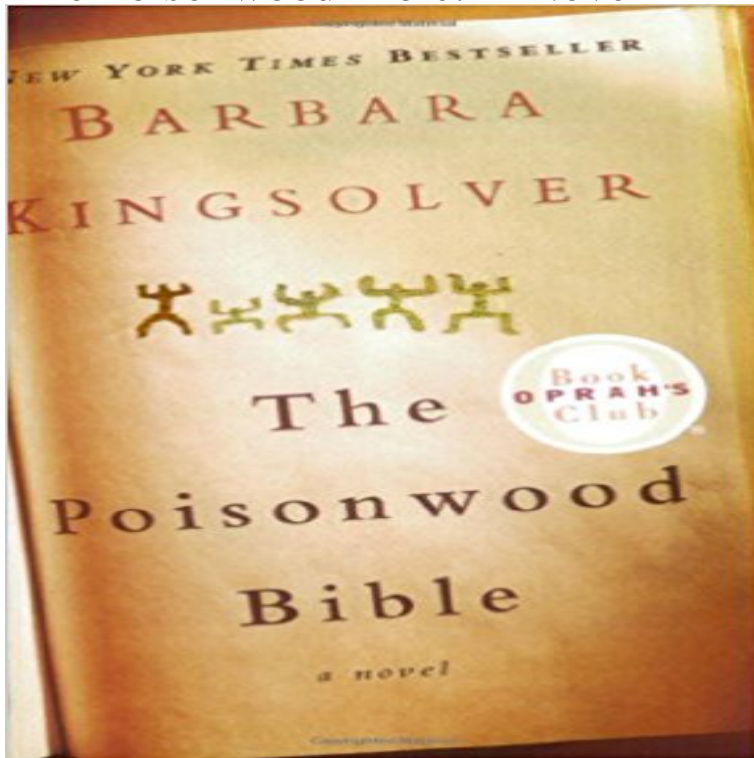


The Poisonwood Bible: A Novel
