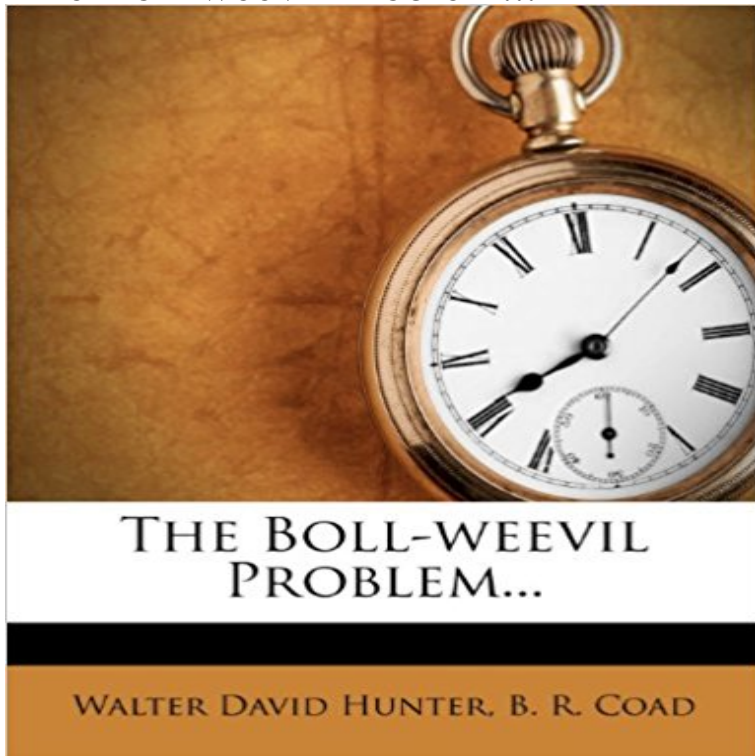


## The Boll-weevil Problem...
