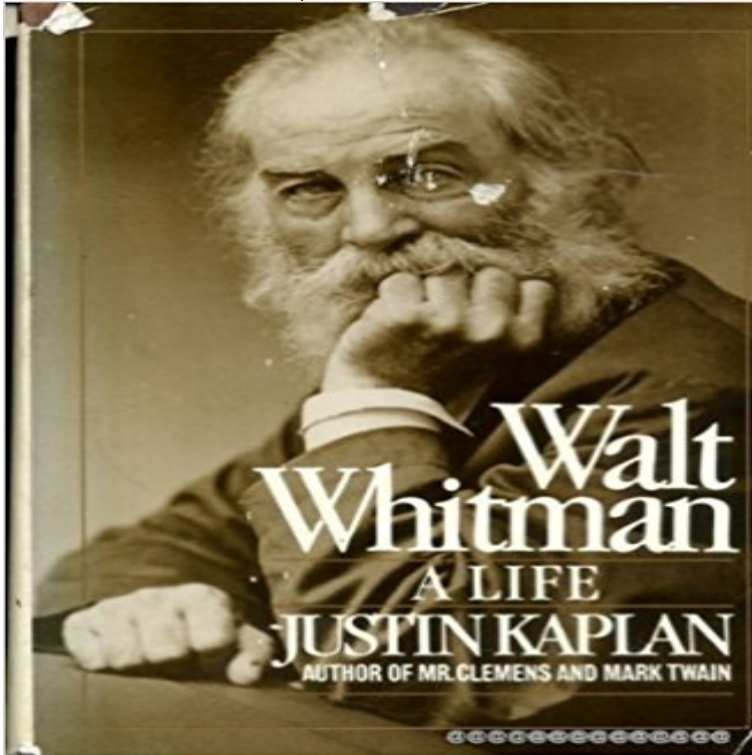


Walt Whitman, A Life
