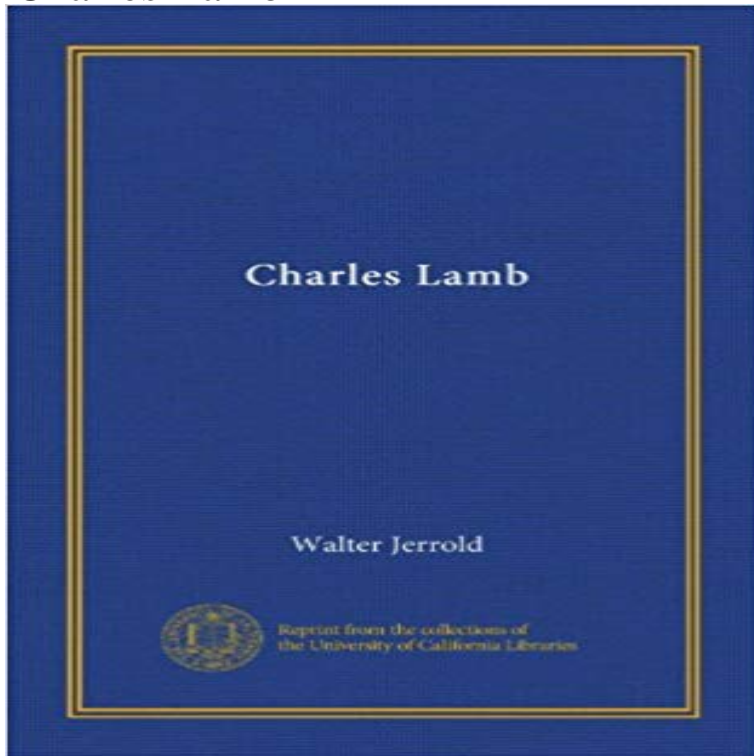


## Charles Lamb
