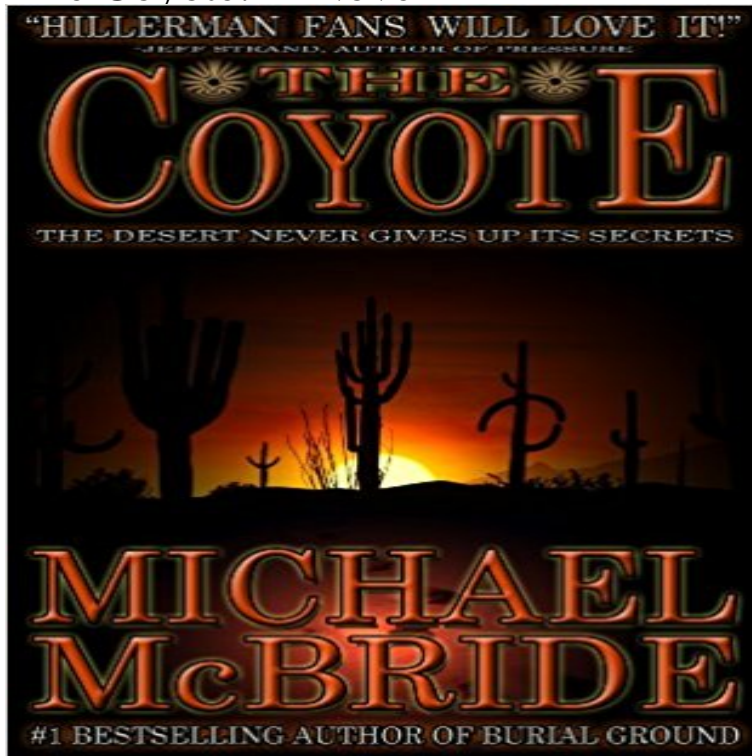


The Coyote: A Novel
