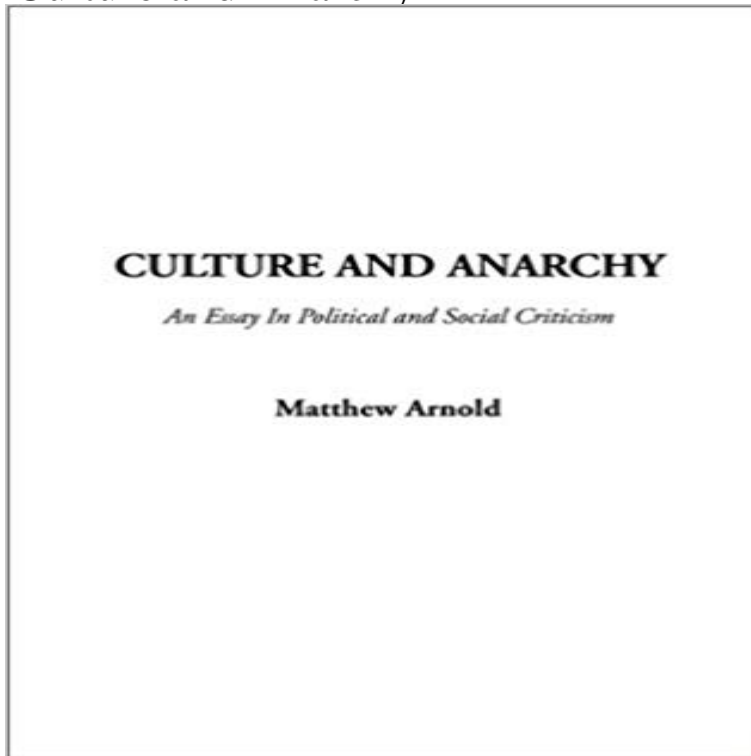


Culture and Anarchy
