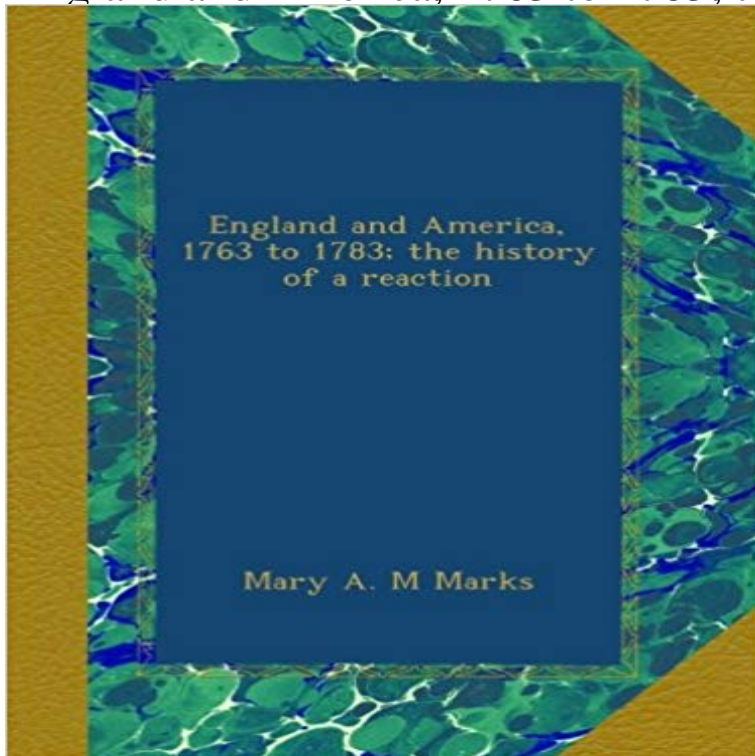


England and America, 1763 to 1783; the history of a reaction
