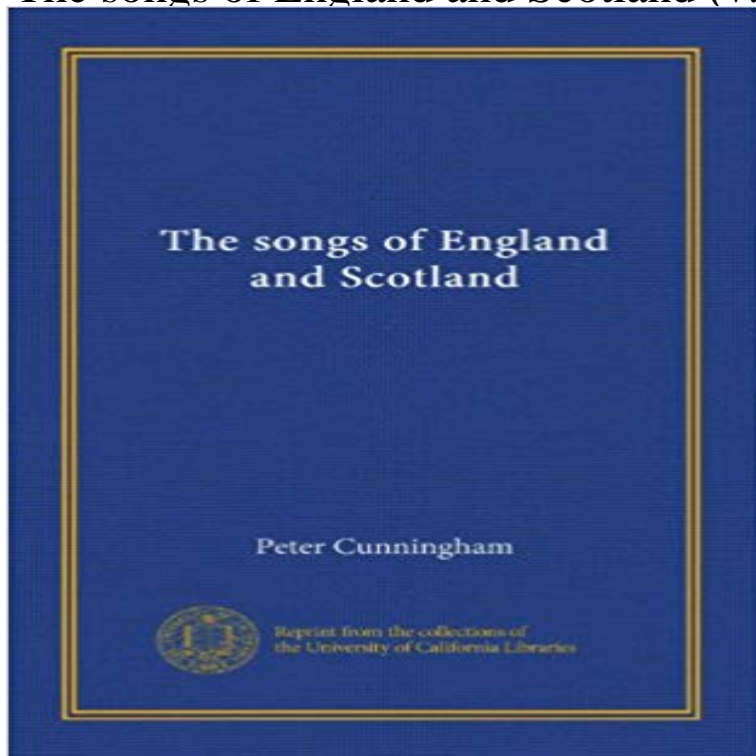


The songs of England and Scotland (v.2)
