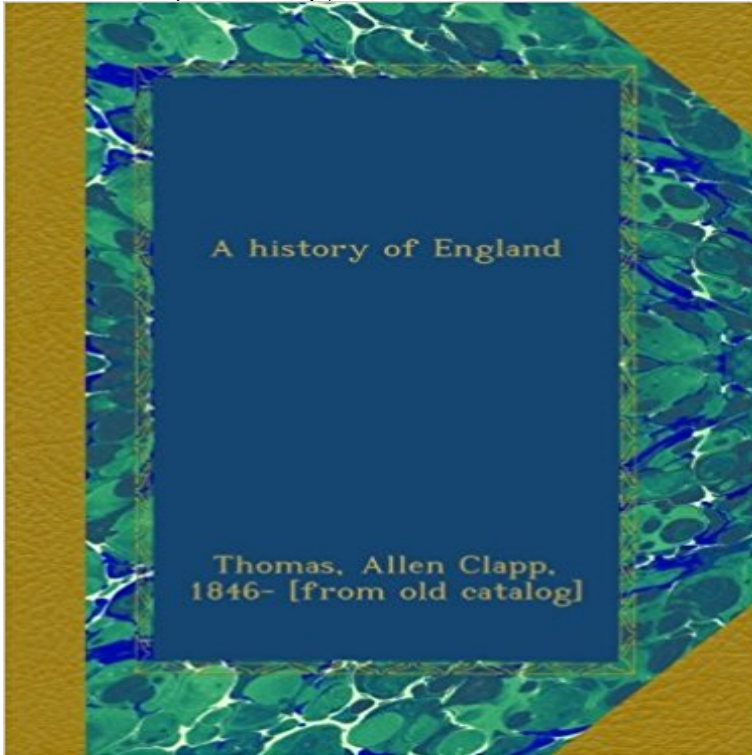


A history of England
