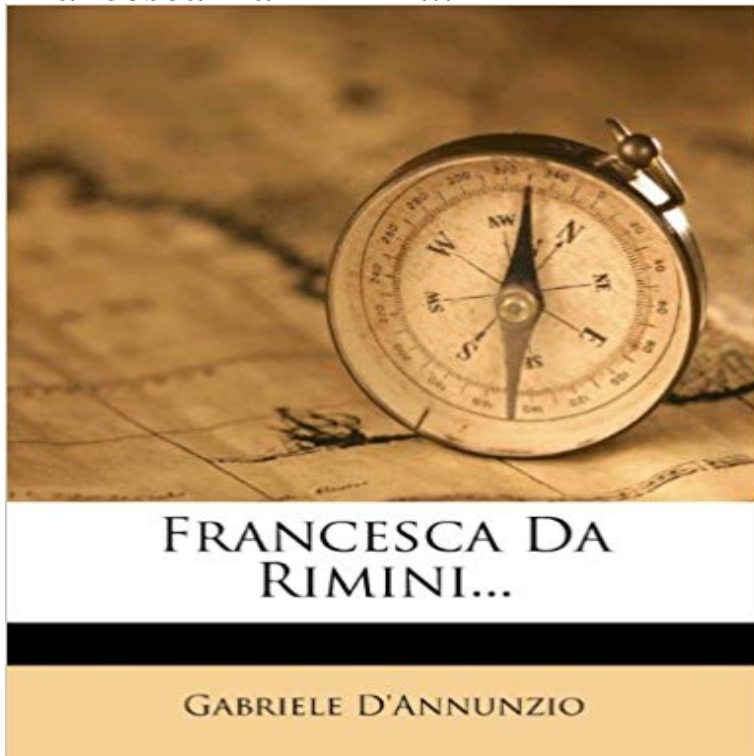


## Francesca Da Rimini...
