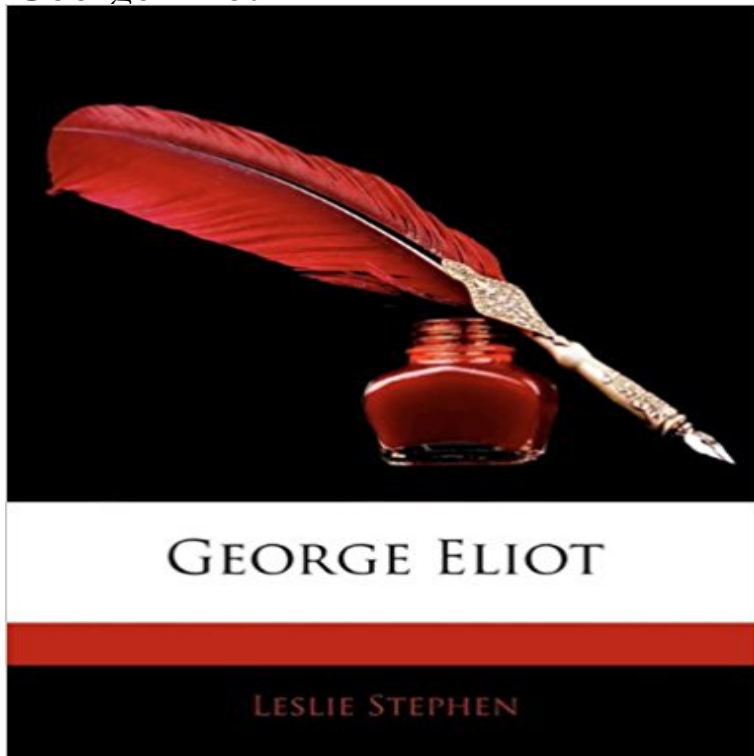


George Eliot
