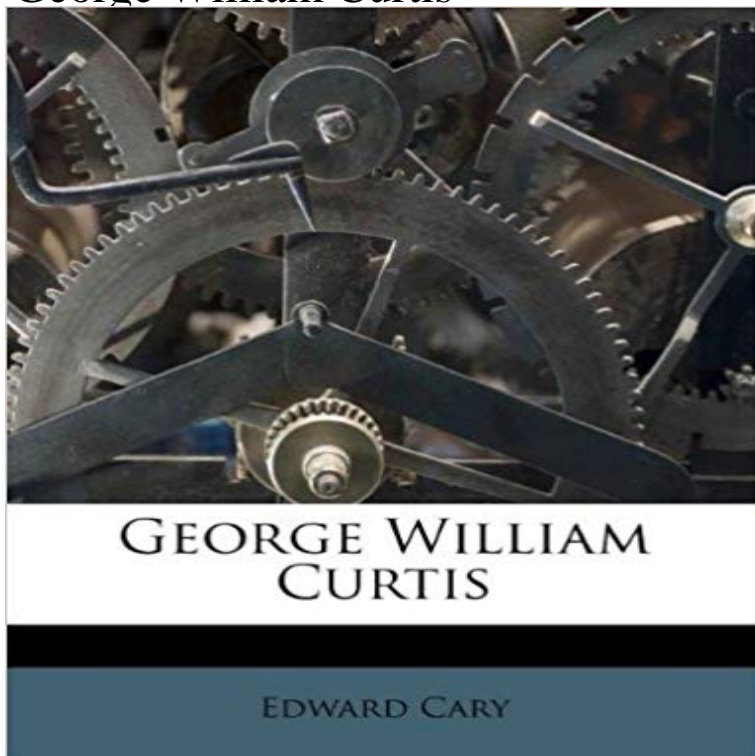


## George William Curtis
