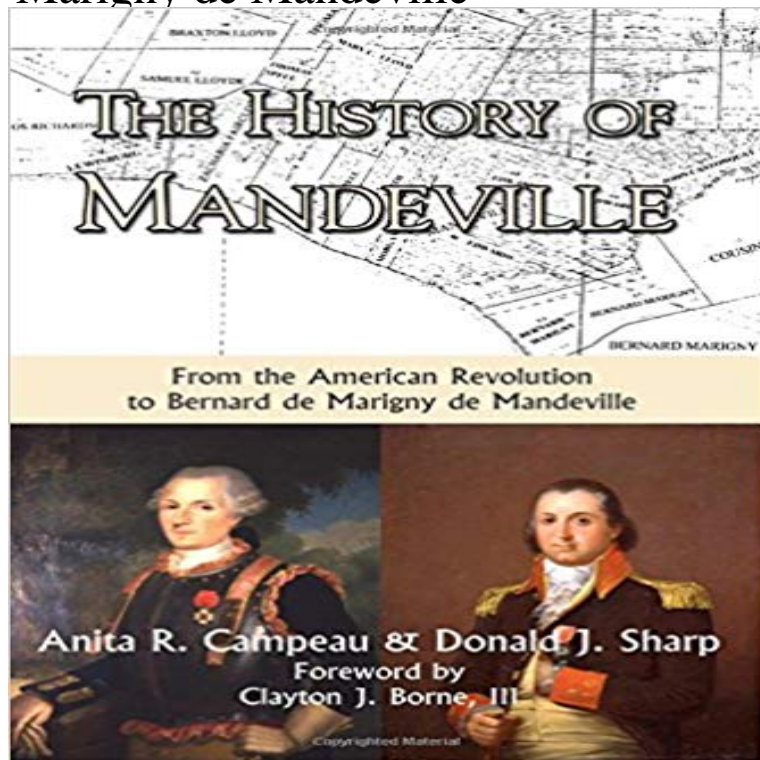


# The History of Mandeville: From the American Revolution to Bernard de Marigny de Mandeville
