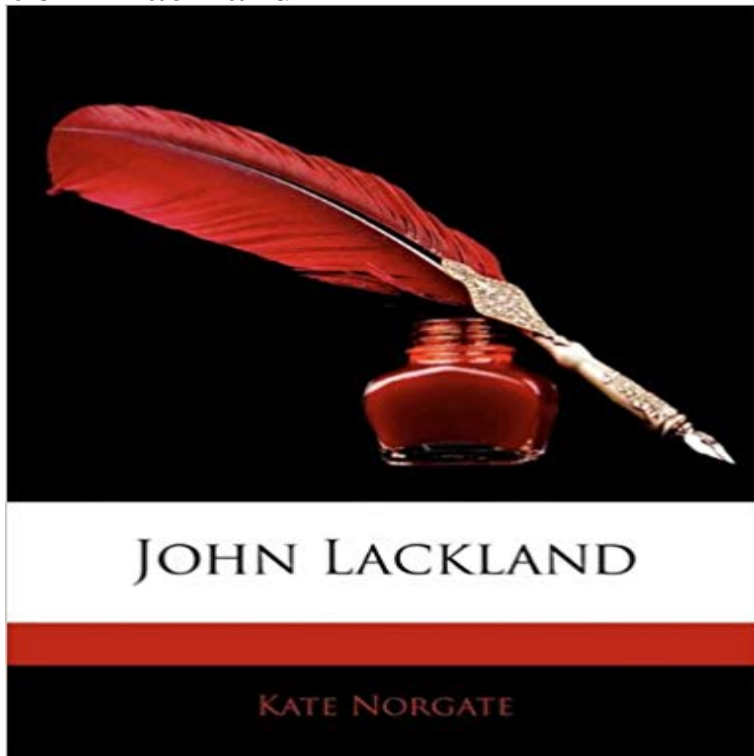


John Lackland
