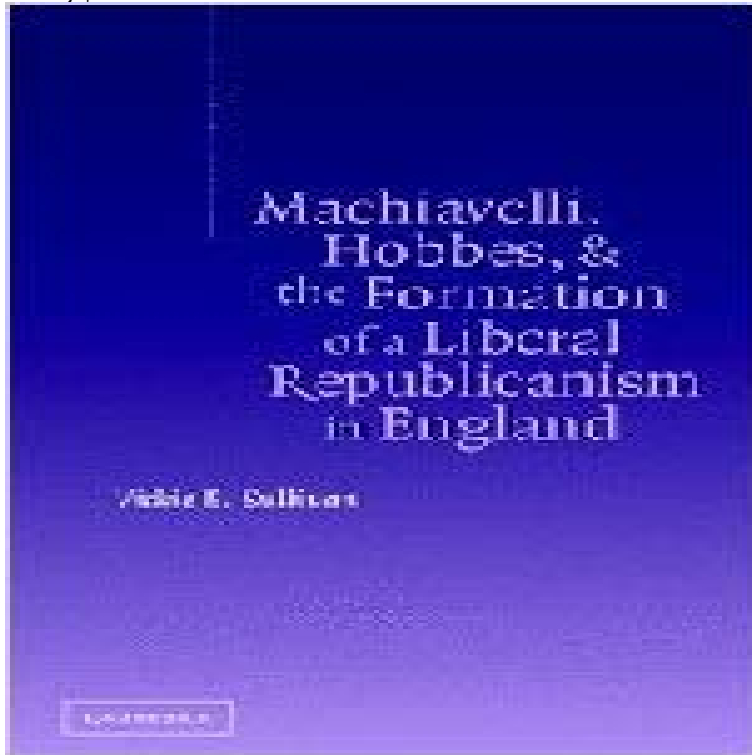


Machiavelli, Hobbes, and the Formation of a Liberal Republicanism in England
