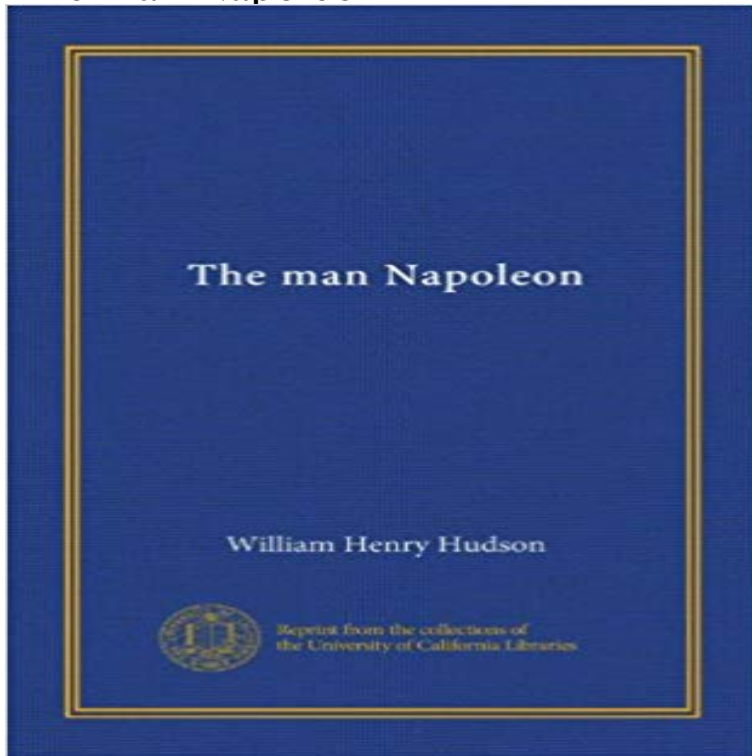


The man Napoleon
