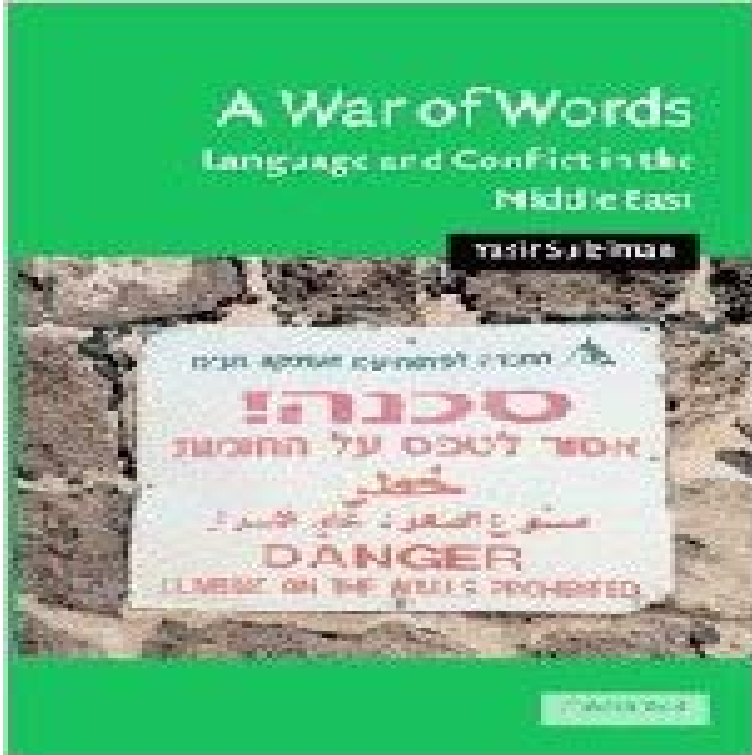


A War of Words: Language and Conflict in the Middle East (Cambridge Middle East Studies)
