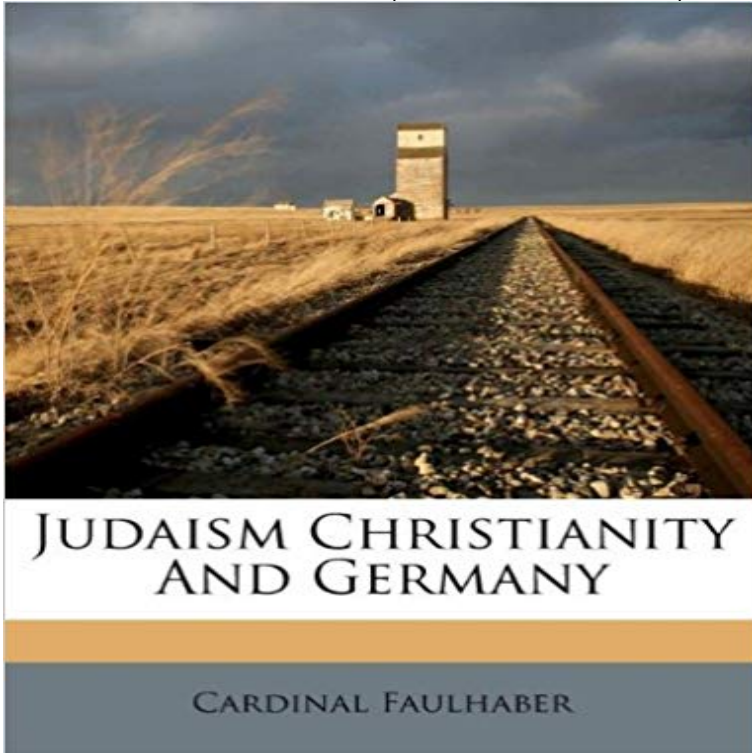


## Judaism Christianity And Germany
