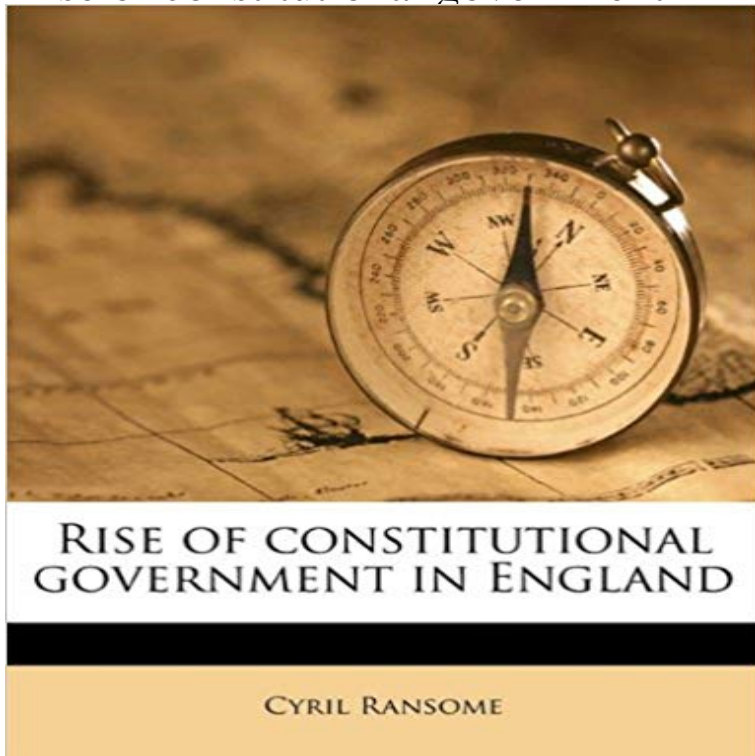


Rise of constitutional government in England
