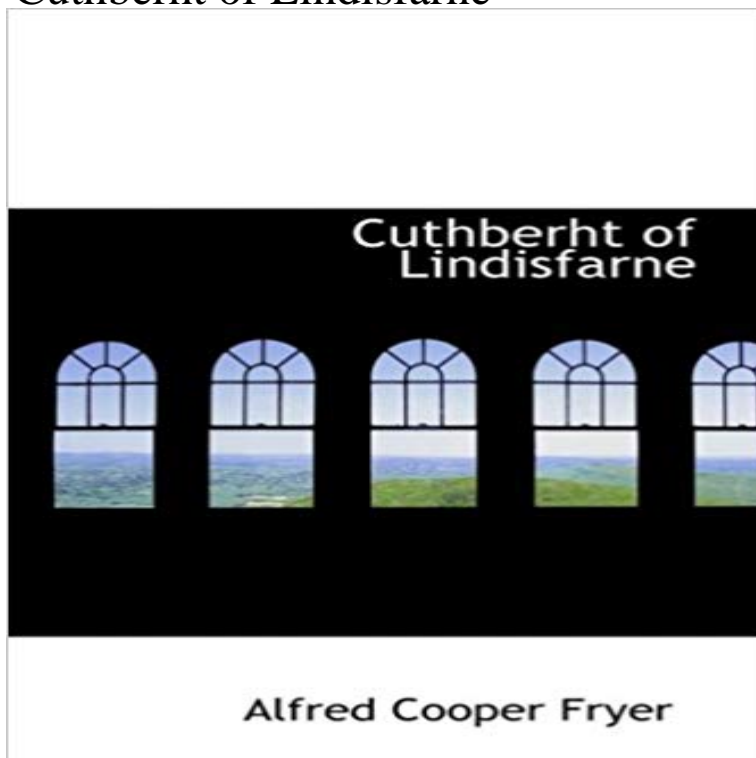


Cuthberht of Lindisfarne
