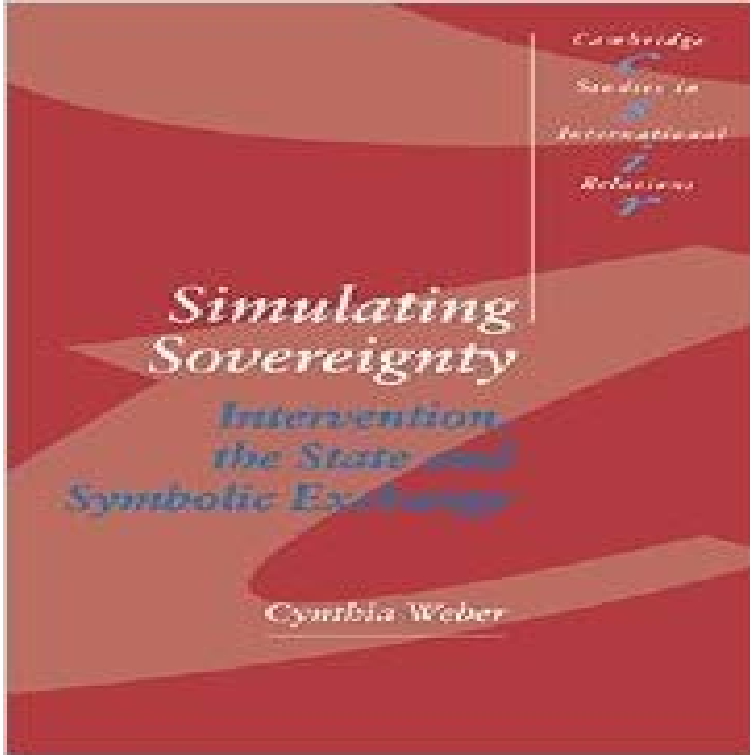


Simulating Sovereignty: Intervention, the State and Symbolic Exchange (Cambridge Studies in International Relations)
