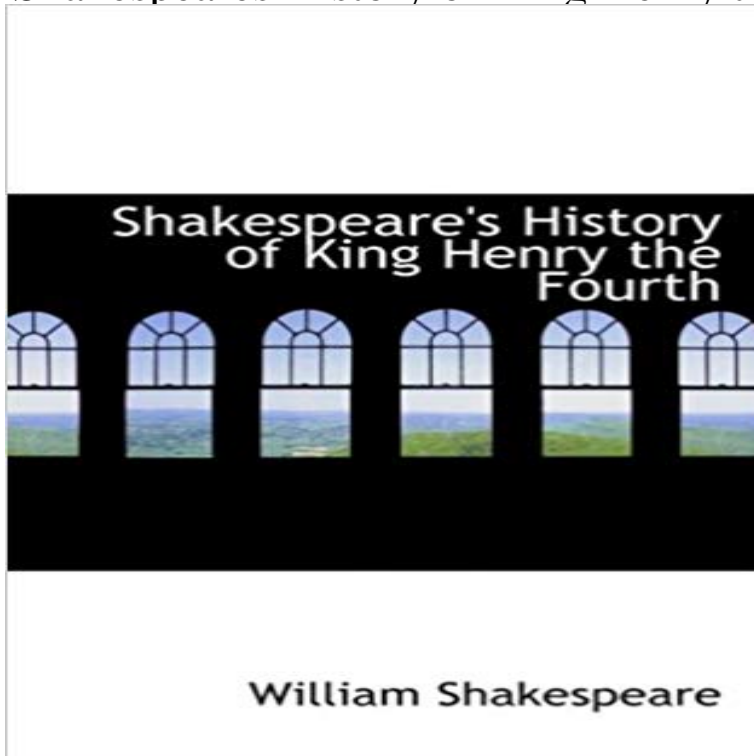


Shakespeares History of King Henry the Fourth
