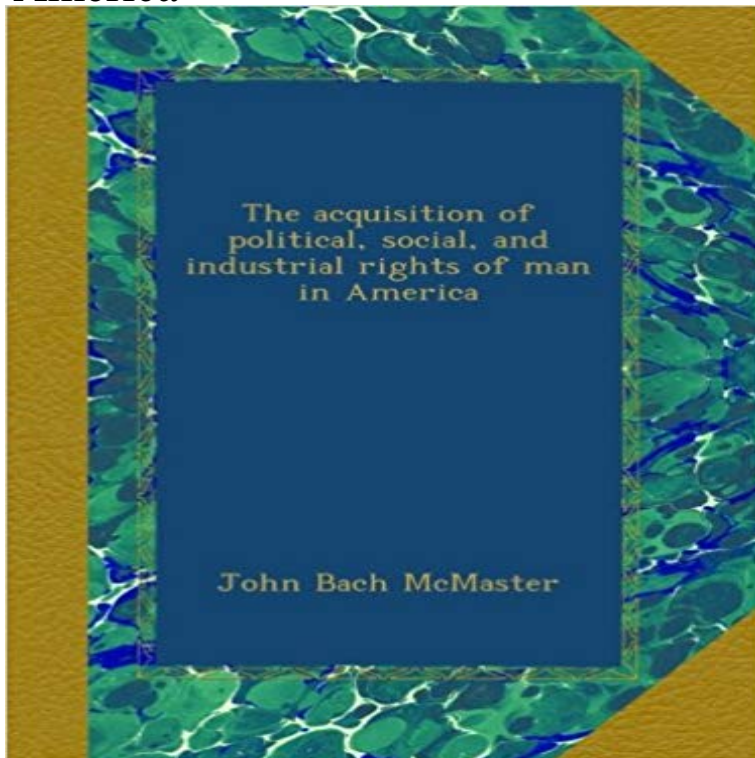


# The acquisition of political, social, and industrial rights of man in America
