
The Death and Life of Drama: Reflections on Writing and Human Nature

Lee also proposes a novel five act structure for drama that takes account of the characters past and future outside the beginning, middle, and end of the story. Deftly balancing philosophical issues and practical concerns, The Death and Life of Drama offers a rich understanding of the principles of successful dramatic writing for screenwriters and indeed everyone who enjoys movies and wants to know why some films have such enduring appeal for so many people.
