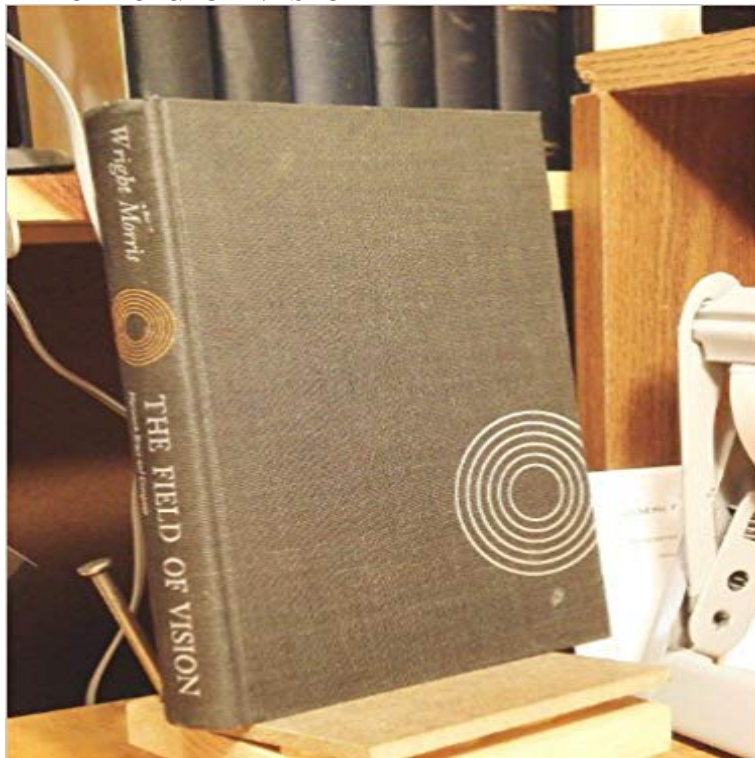


## The field of vision
