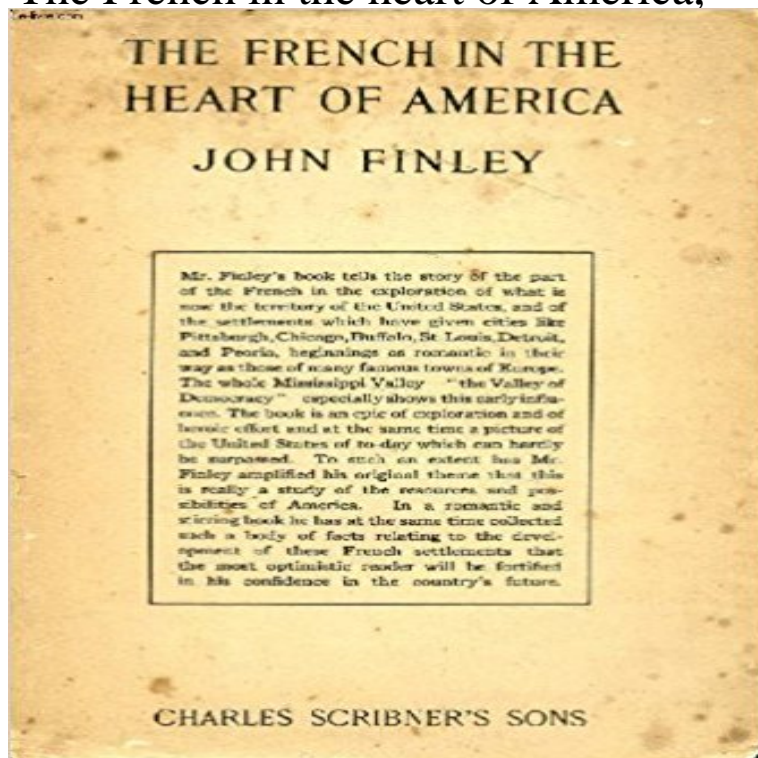


## The French in the heart of America,
