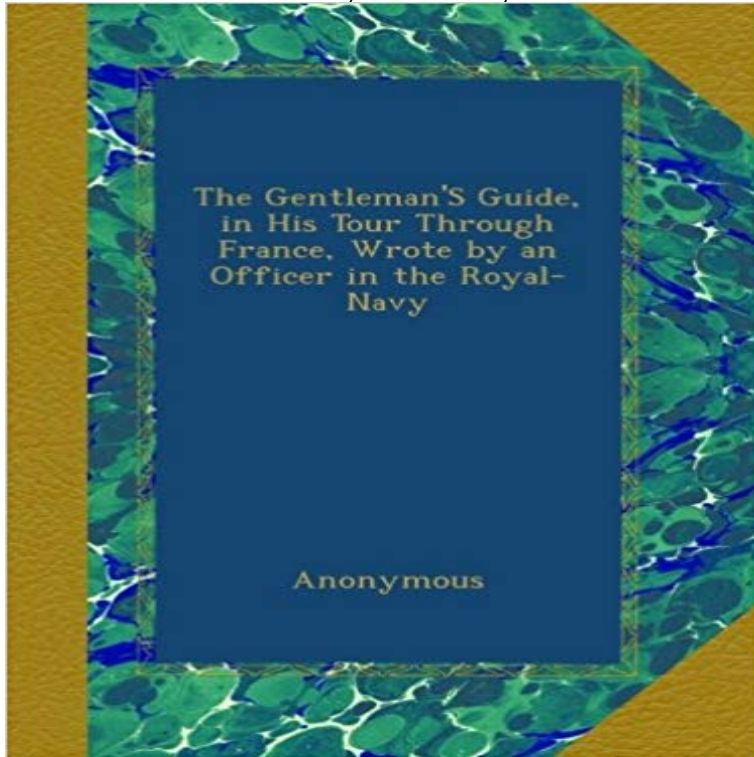


# The GentlemanS Guide, in His Tour Through France, Wrote by an Officer in the Royal-Navy
