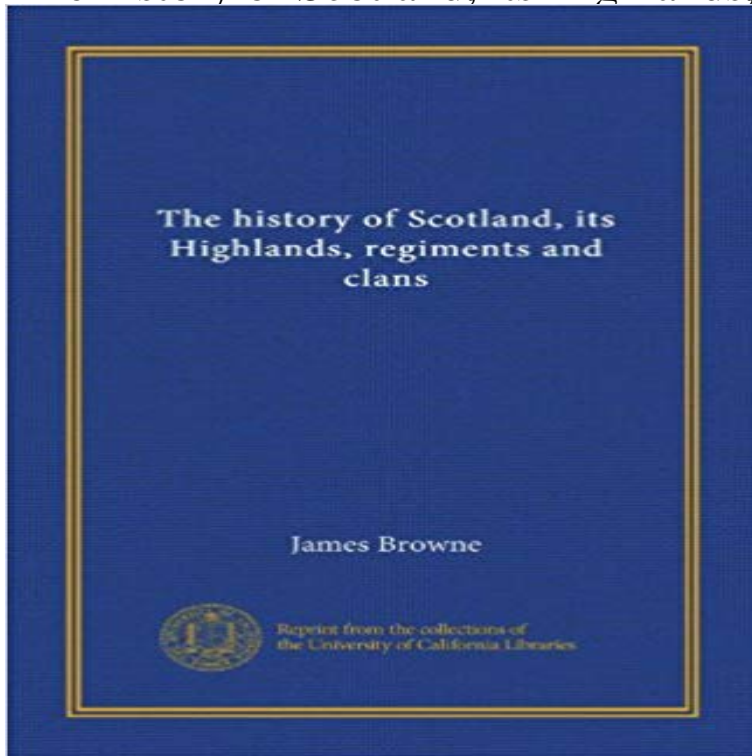


## The history of Scotland, its Highlands, regiments and clans (v.2)
