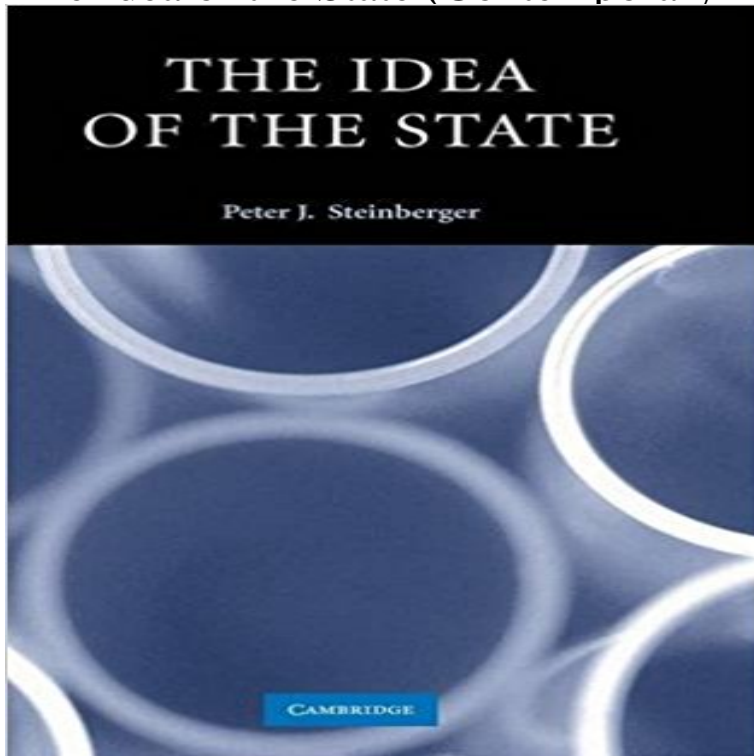


The Idea of the State (Contemporary Political Theory)
