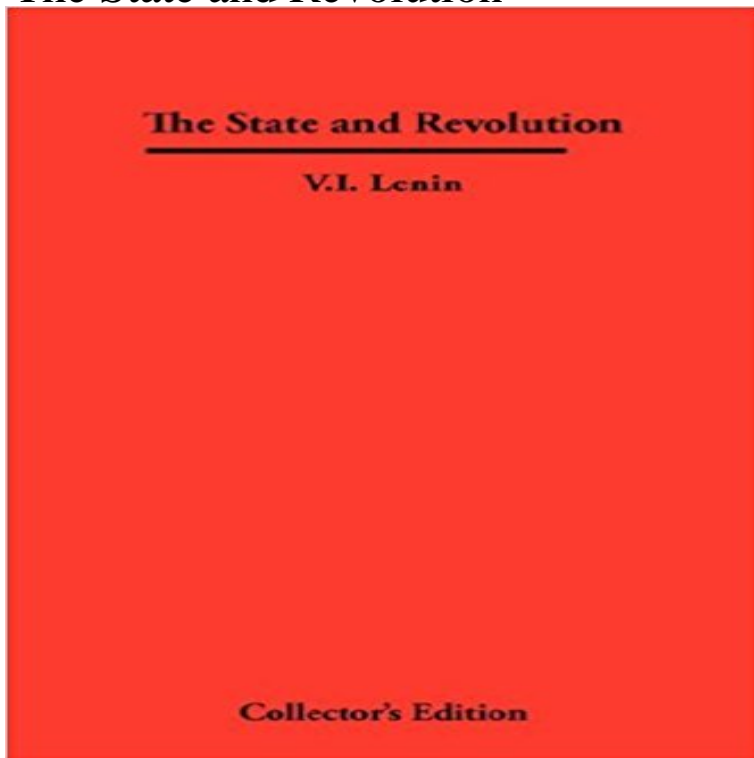


# The State and Revolution
