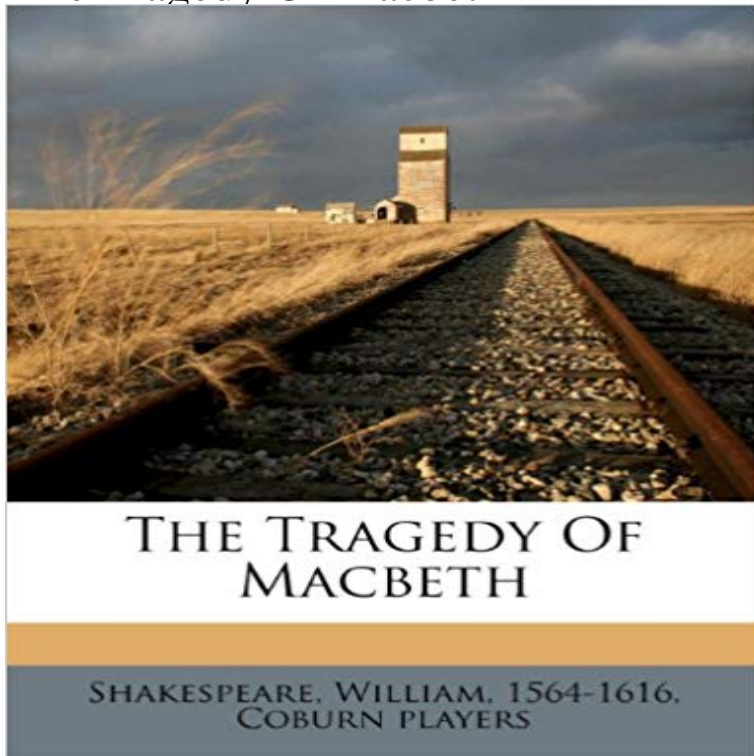


# The Tragedy Of Macbeth
