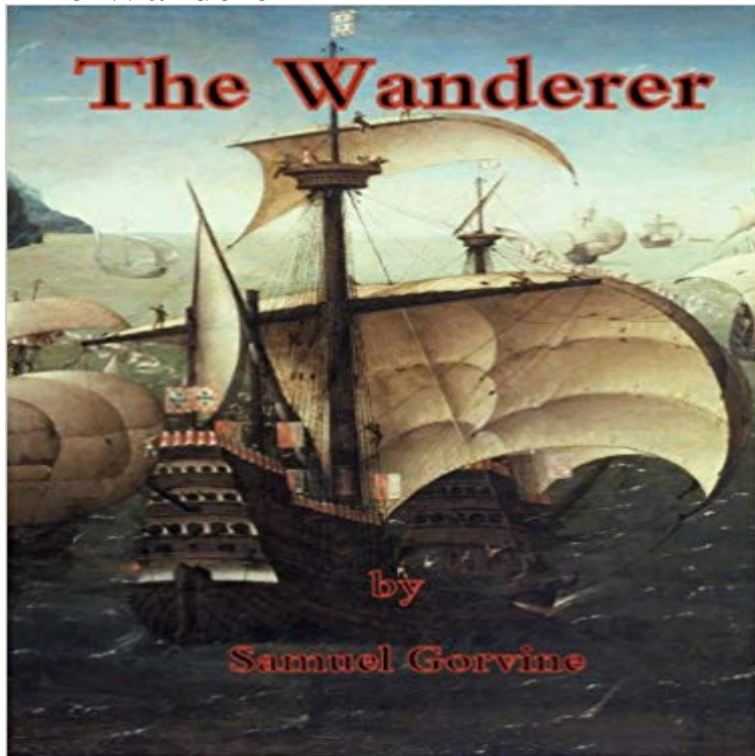


The Wanderer
