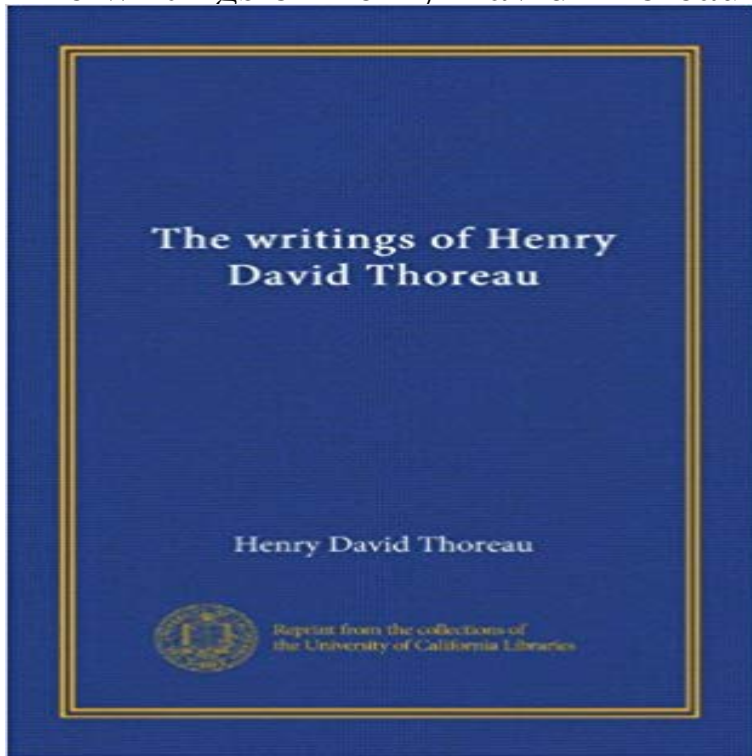


## The writings of Henry David Thoreau
