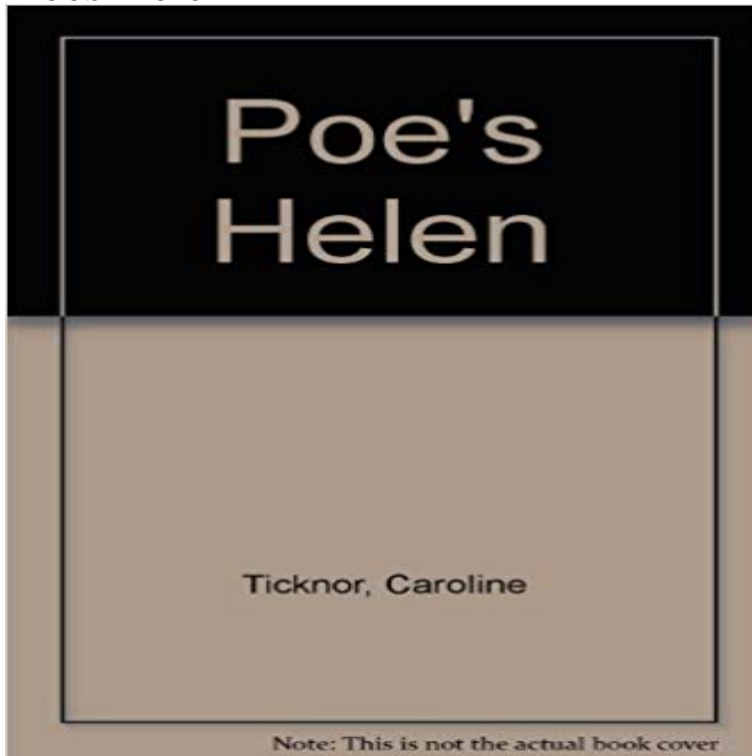


Poes Helen
