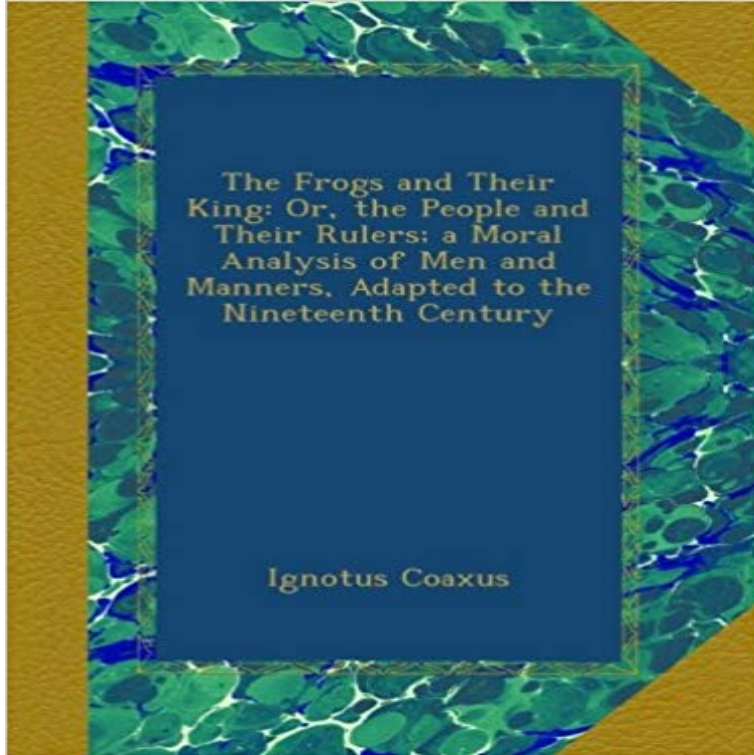


The Frogs and Their King: Or, the People and Their Rulers; a Moral Analysis of Men and Manners, Adapted to the Nineteenth Century
